- Communication and PR with other stakeholders namely consumer groups, environmental and other civil society entities.




Albania GDP in current prices (USD Billion)



- Gross domestic product (GDP) growth rate 2023, is 3.6%.
- Projected GDP 2024 is 3.7%,
- Inflation 2023 stands at 4.7%, driven by food and beverage inputs.
- Projected inflation 2024 is 3.9% and is expected to be stabilized at 3.0% in long term.


SIZE OF CONTRIBUTION OF CONSTRUCTION





TREND OF PERMITS

During the period 2017-2023 by type (number of permits)

Building trends by number



- The permit area is 592,660 sqm in year 2023.
- Apart from 2020 (due to Covid) the trend of number of permits is incremental.
- Increase of building permits in 2021 also impacted from the recovery post earthquake in 2019.
- Residential building growth is increasing also in other cities apart from capital or largest cities, due to tourism mainly.

FACTS AND FIGURES

Albanian Construction Industry

- In Q4 2023, 303 new building permits were approved, down 27% from 415 in Q4 2022.
- The total area of new building permits in Q4 2023 is 592,660 m², up 6.6% from 555,779 m² in Q4 2022 (tab.3).
- The value of building permits issued in Q4 2023 is approximately 253 million EUR.

TOURISM AND CONSTRUCTION

- In 2024, Albania ranked 1st globally for a 116.6% increase in international visitors from 2019.
- Top European Destination for Tourist Influx 2023 (UN Tourism Barometer).
- 7.5 million international arrivals in 2022,
 10.1 million in 2023.
- 2023 GDP: USD 23 billion, up from USD
 12.3 billion in 2012.
- International tourism: 46% of total exports, 65% of services exports.
- Tourism in Albania: Expected CAGR of ~7.5% (2024-2029, Statista).
